To achieve this goal, the Turing Trust:

- Encourages the re-use and recycling of all materials where possible
- Ensures that appropriate markets are found for the sustainable use of its equipment
- Encourages all partner groups and subcontractors to take an environmentally aware approach
- Promotes the responsible and most environmentally safe disposal of equipment when recycling or re-use is not possible
- Minimises waste in all its operations
- Complies with the EU WEEE Directive (2012/19/EU)
